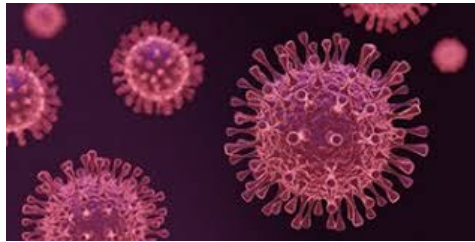


Rhineland Battlefield Tours measures in respect of COVID-19 (new coronavirus)



From 1 June 2020 Rhineland Battlefield Tours will be subject to the following COVID-19 measures.

From this date tours may again be given to groups not larger than 30 persons including the guide.

1. Before the start of the tour, the guide must be in possession of the address and telephone details of all participants in order to carry out a contact inquiry if necessary. In the privacy statement you can read how we handle your data.
2. We do not shake hands to greet you.
3. Prior to the tour, on the day itself, the guide will personally ask everyone if you have any colds:
 - a. Nose cold
 - b. Runny nose
 - c. Sneeze
 - d. Sore throat
 - e. Slight cough
 - f. Elevation up to 38 degrees
4. If you have any of the above symptoms you may not take part in the tour and a refund will be made. Possible family members are not allowed either.
5. Make sure you, and others around you, cough and sneeze in the inside of the elbow.
6. Use paper handkerchiefs if you cough or sneeze, throw them away immediately and wash your hands. Bring your own paper handkerchiefs and disinfectant gel.
7. Transportation to the various meeting points will be done in your own vehicle, so you follow the guide.
8. At the various meeting points, keep a distance of 1.5 meters.
9. No coffee stops or lunches will be offered. You have to take care of your own food and drinks.
